A special meeting of the Renovo Borough Council was held on this date starting at 6:10 pm in Council Chambers, 128 5th Street, Renovo, PA. The meeting was called to order by Council President Ann Tarantella with the Pledge of Allegiance to our Flag. The following Council Members were present; Rhonda Balchun, David Knauff, Patricia Rauch, Kristy Serafini-Brooks (arrived at 6:15). Also in attendance were Secretary/Treasurer Ashley Sporny, Grants Advisor Kari Kepler. Absent: William Fornwalt III, John Simon, Mayor Bruno.

The purpose of the special meeting was to open bids for the Laurel Street paving project and any other business to come before the borough.

NEW BUSINESS

Grant Advisor Kari Kepler announced the bids received at this time.

The borough received three bids for the Laurel Street paving project:

Glenn O'Hawbaker Inc. -\$91,233.00
HRI-\$86,740.00
Charles Construction Co. -\$85,361.16
(K.Serafini-Brooks arrived at this time.)

A motion was made by R. Balchun and seconded by K. Serafini-Brooks to accept the bid of \$85,361.16 from Charles Construction Co. for \$85,361.16 for the Laurel Street paving project contingent on review of the bid documents by Clinton County. A voice vote was taken, motion passed unanimously.

Borough Secretary informed Council of the upcoming closing for the USDA Loan/Grant for the purchase of the F-350 Borough Streets Department Work Truck. USDA Area Specialist, Judy Bartlett sent an email to inform Council that the closing will be happening hopefully within the next month or two.

A motion was made by D.Knauff and seconded by K.Serafini-Brooks to pay the amount of \$49,439.76, to hold the truck at Zook Motors, from the American Rescue Plan funds until USDA funds are received. A voice vote was taken, motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by R.Balchun and seconded by D.Knauff to appoint Jeff Kreger as Sewage Enforcement Officer and Sean Kreger as Alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer. A voice vote was taken, motion passed unanimously.

Grants Advisor Kari Kepler recommended the Borough Secretary contact Borough Engineer Donnie Stevenson to revamp the Delaware Avenue Streets Rehabilitation application for the CFA Multimodal Grant, should council decide to move forward with applying in July.

Kepler also advised Council of another grant that will be closing in August called Safe Streets for all. The Borough Secretary will look into this grant and get back to council on possibly applying.

A motion was made by K.Serafini-Brooks and seconded by P.Rauch to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 pm. A voice vote was taken, motion passed unanimously.
