

RENOVO BOROUGH RESIDENTS

It is the responsibility of the owner or tenant of every property in the Renovo Borough to remove from all the sidewalks in front of or alongside such property all snow and ice within twenty-four (24) hours after all snow and ice have ceased to fall. This is in accordance with Ordinance 636. Any person who violates Ordinance 636 will be prosecuted.

RENOVO BOROUGH RESIDENTS

Huron Avenue is a Snow Emergency Route. Parking is prohibited on this street during a snow/ice emergency. A snow emergency shall be defined as any accumulation of snow, sleet, or hail which shall total a measurable depth of two inches (2") or more, at some point within the Borough of Renovo. During a snow/ice emergency please park your vehicles on the North and East sides of the street on odd days of the month. On the even days of the month park your vehicles on the South and West sides of the street until all snow has been removed to the curb line, or the emergency is cancelled. **After the snow and ice have been plowed from the streets, it shall be illegal to deposit or throw snow or ice back onto the streets.** This is in accordance with Ordinance 796. Any person who violates Ordinance 796 will be prosecuted.
